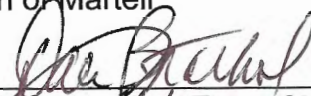
An Ordinance to require fire inspections of all commercial buildings.

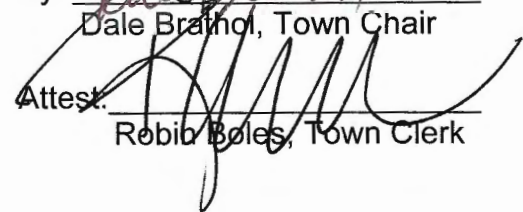
The Town Board of the Town of Martell does hereby ordain as follows:

- Section 1. The Ellsworth Fire Department shall be responsible for conducting all fire inspections of commercial buildings, premises and thoroughfares which are located in that part of the Town with respect to which fire protection services have been contracted with the Ellsworth Fire Department.
- Section 2. The inspections shall be conducted annually, provided the interval shall be not less than as specified in SPS314.01(13)(b)7 or other State Statutory or administrative code provision.
- Section 3. When any inspection reveals a fire hazard the Inspector may serve a notice in writing upon the owner of the property giving said owner a reasonable time in which to remove the hazard. If the hazard is not removed it shall be deemed a nuisance and may be removed by the Town with the cost thereof entered upon the tax roll as a special charge against the property.
- Section 4. No person shall deny the Chief or his deputies free access to any property within the Town at any reasonable time for the purpose of making fire inspections. No person shall hinder or obstruct the Fire Inspector in the performance of his duty, or refuse to observe any lawful direction given by him.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect on passage and publication/posting as required by law.

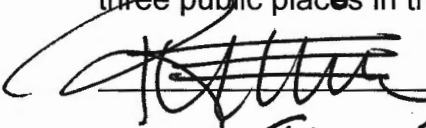
